 - **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Specialist Joey Lenz5 Act of 2025".

1 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR PERIODIC HEALTH ASSESS-2 MENTS.

Chapter 55 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by inserting after section 10740 the following new section (and conforming the table of sections accordingly):

6 "§ 1074p. Periodic health assessments

7 "Beginning in 2026, the Secretary of Defense shall
8 ensure that periodic health assessments provided to a
9 member of the armed forces include the following:

10 "(1) On an annual basis— "(A) a sports physical: 11 12 "(B) an electrocardiogram; and "(C) blood work that includes— 13 14 "(i) a comprehensive metabolic panel 15 and complete blood count; and 16 "(ii) if necessary— "(I) a thyroid stimulating hor-17 18 mone test; and 19 "(II) a brain natriuretic peptide 20 test. 21 "(2) Any test or evaluation required by law 22 with respect to such member, including an evalua-23 tion required by section 704 of the National Defense 24 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 25 116–92; 10 U.S.C. 1074f note) and a test required 26 by section 707 of such Act (10 U.S.C. 1074 note).

"(3) Any other test or evaluation determined
 appropriate by the Secretary.".
