I am requesting funding for the Montgomery County Fire Marshal's Office Bomb Squad Sustainment for fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 501 North Thompson St., Conroe, TX 77301.

This project will sustain and support the Montgomery County Fire Marshal Bomb Squad's specialized mission. Montgomery County's Bomb Squad responds regionally throughout Southeast Texas, including Houston, and supports jurisdictions who do not have these specialized capabilities. Specifically, funds will be used to ensure the bomb squad's equipment meets the necessary certifications to safely respond to, and render safe, explosive devices in addition to other hazards, like suspicious packages and bomb threats. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under, and consistent with, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
